We research, evaluate, and discern where and how God is leading us to deploy Mergon's resources for the greatest Kingdom impact.

South Africa

We focus on discipling the next generation in the education journey and young adults in vulnerable communities by engaging Kingdom catalytic partnerships with organisations working to restore dignity by instigating hope in Christ and access to a self-sustainable future.

Sub-Saharan Africa

We believe that 'a well-chosen team' of partners can achieve greater impact when connected and encouraged to work together than anything each can do on their own. With that in mind, we want to partner with ministries that can work collaboratively towards reaching and equipping the next generation of young Africans, empowering of women, equipping the existing church in leadership and theology, and reaching the remaining unreached people groups.

Middle East & North Africa

Our current country focus includes Israel, Iran, Turkey, Morocco, Egypt, Saudi Arabia, and Lebanon. Within these countries we engage with discipleship orientated ministries to women, youth, children, and refugees. We also engage with media ministries and networks aiming to enhance the impact of indigenous ministry initiatives in accelerating the expansion of the Gospel message in the region.
